

**Crocheted Piratical Eye Patch**  
by Maggie McDonald for The Black Sheep  
San Diego Yarn Crawl 2017



Yarn: Heavy, worsted weight, approx. 4 sts/in. (black)  
Approximately 7 yds. required (varies by your gauge).  
Crochet hook: US #H

Abbreviations:

ch. chain  
sc single crochet  
st./sts. stitch / stitches  
turn turn your work

Leaving a 20" tail, make a slip knot.

Row 1. ch. 2. Turn your work.  
Row 2. Make 1 sc in 2nd ch. from hook. Turn. 1 st.  
Row 3. ch. 1, make 3 sc in next st. Turn. 3 sts.  
Row 4. ch. 1, 2 sc in first st., 1 sc in next st, 2 sc in last st. Turn. 5 sts.  
Row 5. ch. 1, 1 sc in each st. Turn. 5 sts.  
Row 6. ch. 1, 2 sc in first st., 1 sc in next 3 sts., 1 sc in last st. Turn. 7 sts.  
Row 7. ch. 1, 1 sc in each st. Turn. 7 sts.  
Row 8. ch. 1, 2 sc in first st., 1 sc in next 5 sts., 2 sc in last st. Turn. 9 sts.  
Rows 9-12. ch. 1, 1 sc in each st. Turn. 9 sts.  
Row 13. ch. 1, skip first st., 1 sc in next 6 sts., skip 1 st., 1 sc in last st. Turn. 7 sts.  
Row 14. ch. 1, 1 sc in each st. Turn. 7 sts.  
Row 15. ch. 1, skip first st., 1 sc in next 4 sts., skip 1 st., 1 sc in last st. Turn. 5 sts.  
Row 16. ch. 1, 1 sc in each st. Turn. 5 sts.  
Row 17. ch. 1, skip first st., 1 sc in next 2 sts., skip 1 st., 1 sc in last st. Turn. 3 sts.  
Row 18. ch. 1, skip first st., 1 sc in next 2 sts. Turn. 2 sts.  
Row 19. ch. 1, skip first st., 1 sc in next st. 1 st.

Cut yarn 20" from hook and pull tail through final loop. Use the 20" tails to tie patch around head.

Wear and enjoy!

**Knitted Piratical Eye Patch**

Yarn: Heavy, worsted weight, approx. 4 sts/in. (black)  
Approximately 7 yds. required (varies by your gauge).  
Knitting needles: US 9

Abbreviations:

K knit  
Kfb knit front and back. An increase  
K2tog Knit 2 together. A decrease  
PSSO Pass slipped stitch over. A decrease  
SSK slip, slip, knit. A decrease  
st./sts. stitch / stitches

Leaving 20" tail, make a slip knot.

Cast on 1 st. (2 sts. on needle, including slip knot)  
Row 1. Kfb, K1. 3sts.  
Row 2. Kfb, Kfb, K1. 5 sts.  
Row 3. K all sts. 5sts.  
Row 4. Kfb, K2, Kfb, K1. 7 sts.  
Row 5. K all sts. 7 sts.  
Row 6. Kfb, K4, Kfb, K1. 9 sts.  
Row 7. K all sts. 9 sts.  
Row 8. Kfb, K6, Kfb, K1. 11 sts.  
Rows 9-13. K all sts. 11 sts.  
Row 14. K1, SSK, K5, K2tog, K1. 9 sts.  
Row 15. K all sts. 9 sts.  
Row 16. K1, SSK, K3, K2tog, K1. 7 sts.  
Row 17. K all sts. 7 sts.  
Row 18. K1, SSK, K1, K2tog, K1. 5 sts.  
Row 19. K all sts. 5 sts.  
Row 20. Slip 1 st., K2tog, PSSO, K1. 3 sts.  
Row 21. K1, K2tog. 2 sts.  
Row 22. K2tog. 1 st.

Cut yarn 20" from end of needle and pull tail through final loop. Use the 20" tails to tie patch around head.

Wear and enjoy!
